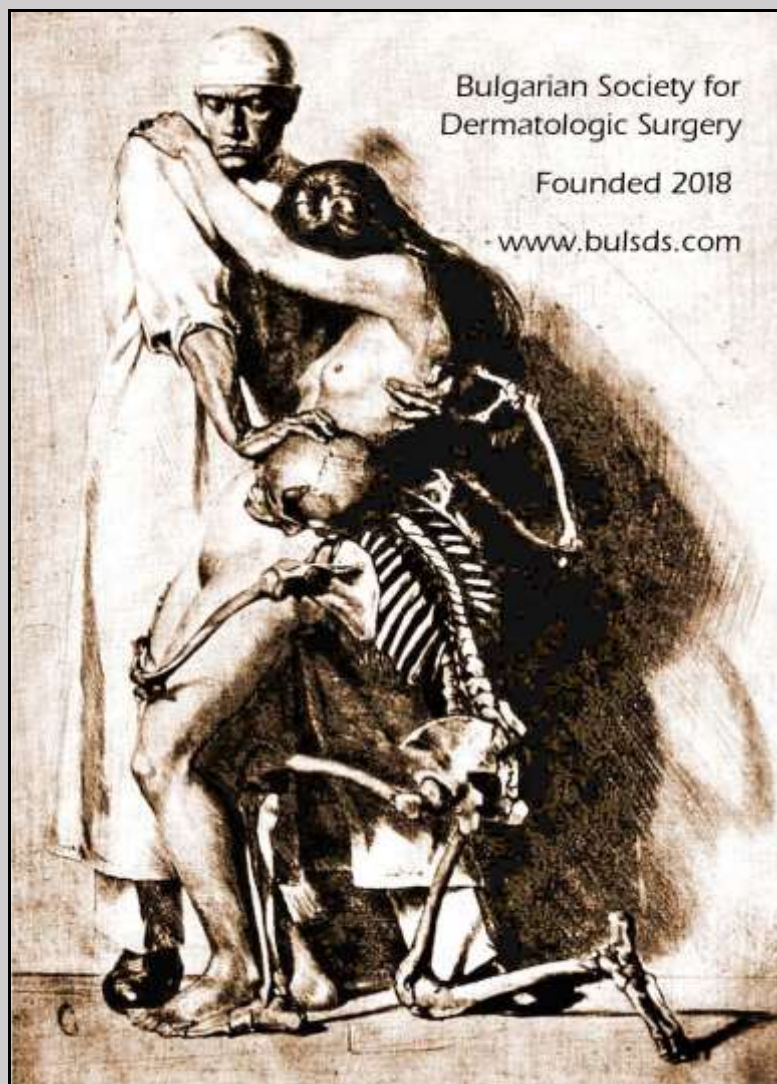

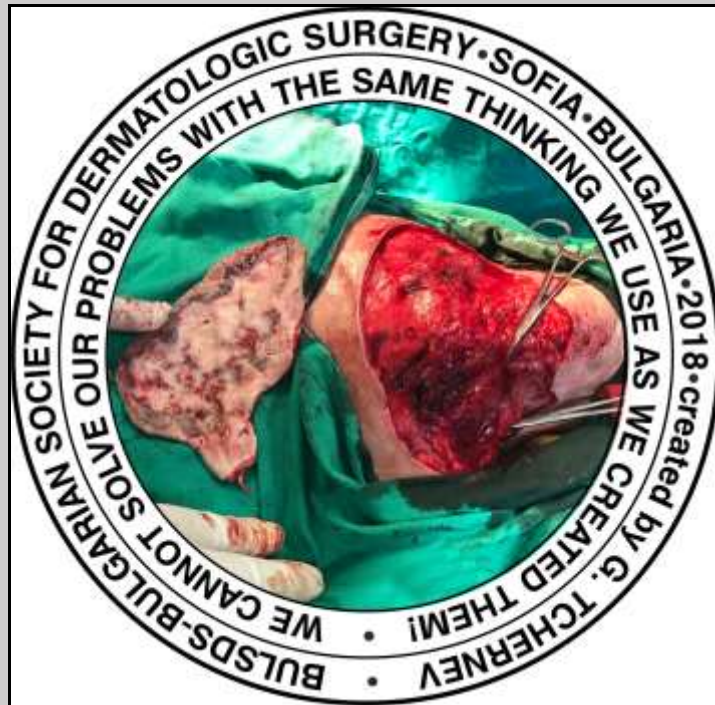

2. Adult patient with relapsed refractory DBLC (diffuse B cell large lymphoma) with cutaneous involvement: successful treatment with pixantrone. 10 min.
3. Primary Cutaneous diffuse anaplastic large B cell lymphoma developing in an old surgical cicatrix. 6 min.
4. Tumorous lethal formation of the forehead. 7 min.
5. Seborrhic pemphigus and the potential links to molecular mimicry. 8 min.
